- Ability to work independently.
- Dependable and committed to your scheduled shift.
- Willingness to work in all weather conditions.
- Interest in increasing your knowledge of animal welfare, behavior and care.
- Excellent communication skills.

Responsibilities:

- Provide dogs with appropriate exercise, enrichment, play and positive physical contact.
- Encourage positive behaviours and basic leash skills as directed.
- Provide affection with petting and grooming.
- Assist prospective adopters, by helping them meet & get to know adoptable dogs.

Time Commitment

- Program runs 7 days a week.
- Two daily shifts available: morning and afternoon
- Volunteers are required to commit to one 2 – 3 hours shift, per week.

Number of positions

Requirements for the Position

- Volunteer application
- Attend orientation session
- Complete interview & submit criminal record check
- Participate in workshop & buddy training sessions
- Report to FSPCA staff
